In January, U.S. Attorney General William Barr named Attorney General Moody to the <u>President's Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Justice</u>. The Commission is exploring modern issues affecting law enforcement that most impact the ability of American policing to reduce crime. The Commission will meet monthly for the next year and then report its findings to the U.S. Attorney General, who will submit a final report to the President.
